Before long your child will settle right into his or her new routine.

Learning themes return in September as we focus on getting back into the swing of the school day. We will also introduce some seasonal fruits and vegetables, so we'll have lots of taste testing (especially apples!) and we may even make some homemade applesauce.

As usual, 😊 a couple of reminders:

- 🍏 Please make sure to label all of your child's belongings. We have new staff members who won't be familiar with which lunch box or jacket belongs to which child (it also helps with keeping the day running smoothly). Labeling includes water bottles, clothing, backpacks ... if you bring it, please label it. Thanks!
- 🍏 If your child uses a "lovey" for naptime, please keep it *small and limited to one per child*. Having multiple toys causes a distraction for, not only your child, but the other children in the room. Thank you so much for your help with this!
